How can archives help to answer the question: “Who has shaped energy transitions?”

We are pleased to announce a call for papers for the **the 15th EOGAN Annual Conference**, the network of energy archives and researchers. This year the conference is organised as part of the international conference **“Who has shaped energy transitions? Consumers, businesses, public and social stakeholders (18th-21st century)”** Organised by TotalEnergies in the occasion of the 100th anniversary of the company. You can find the CFP of the conference here. The conference will take place on the **13th and 14th of June 2024** at TotalEnergies Archives, in Paris-La Défense.

Within the conference, Eogan will host a panel dedicated to methodology for energy history research; in particular, we welcome papers and interventions on the subject of ***energy transitions, and how historical archives can shed a light on the concept of energy transitions in history (on a micro level as well as macro level)***

We welcome presentations dealing with “energy transitions”, in a broader sense. Some examples (by all means non exhaustive) are:

- Past and present patterns of electrification and other energy networks
- Technical and political cooperation to promote energy transitions in history
- Past and present patterns of energy production and consumption
- Methodologies for the analysis of long-term datasets

- Sources and methodologies to study energy shifts and energy transitions in history
- Markets, consumers, producers, and actors in energy shifts
- The problem of long-term retention and the gap between current and historical records in nuclear energy and other historical archives

These and other topics should be presented from a methodological perspective (how they were studied / how they can be studied / presentations of available archival collections and tools)

EOGAN provides a network for people working to preserve and promote the use of energy-related records across Europe, including:

- archivists, records managers and records creators in the industry
- oil and gas companies wishing to develop business archives
- museums and organisations with an interest in energy history
- universities and academics working on energy-related topics

The annual EOGAN conference is a meeting place for people to share ideas and develop valuable international links across the energy research and archives sectors.

Following the presentation panel, the annual AGM meeting will present the network and welcome new interested members. Participation into Eogan is completely free of charge.

We invite you to submit papers on the topics mentioned above, or any other aspect of our conference theme – we welcome a wide range of perspectives. Please submit your paper or an abstract of 250-300 words with a working title, to eogan.network@gmail.com by the **1st March 2024**, along with a short biography including your name, email address and affiliation. The conference language will be English.
